- \* The competition is open to all residents of Lymm, there is no theme in particular this year, so let your imagination run riot! (Though, not too difficult please, so that people can have fun identifying the Scarecrows and please give a clue to help identify yours.)
- \* Your Scarecrow should be **safely** erected in your own garden (or even your window), so that it is easily visible from the public footpath or highway. Please ensure that your Scarecrow does not fall and cause an accident or injury to anyone and please make sure that your Scarecrow is appropriate for public display. Unsuitable Scarecrows will not be acceptable for the competition.
- \* We suggest a minimum height of 1 metre and don't forget that your Scarecrow will need to withstand wind and rain for about 3 weeks.
- \* You need to register your Scarecrow, so please complete the entry form below - **entries must be received by 22nd June** and please include your entry fee of £5.
- \* All Scarecrows need to be completed and in position by **Saturday 24th June**. If you wish to take your Scarecrow indoors during hours of darkness, please make sure that it is returned to its position and safely secured first thing in the morning.
- \* Every Scarecrow will be visited on the 24th or 25th June and given a Registration Number.
- \* A Scarecrow Trail will be organised so people can have lots of fun visiting and trying to identify the Scarecrows. There will be a map and a form for people to vote for their favourite Scarecrow and an answer sheet for the title of each Scarecrow - there will be a Prize for the most correct answers.
